This project is currently active. Immunostaining has been completed with a panel of 9 markers on each of 128 metastatic adenocarcinomas. The slides have been reviewed and the data generated. Dr. Kay Dunn is providing statistical analysis of the various marker panels for sensitivity, specificity, positive and negative predictive value relative to a given primary site. When that analysis is complete, we plan to submit the manuscript, which is already in progress, to Human Pathology. In addition, we plan to submit the data in abstract form for the 1995 spring ASCP meeting or USCAP meeting.
